Qualifications for Election Judge

To be an election judge, you

1. Must be a Maryland registered voter residing in the jurisdiction where you will serve, except that:
 - A. If a qualified individual residing in the jurisdiction cannot be found with reasonable effort, the local board of elections may appoint any Maryland registered voter: and
 - B. The local board of elections may appoint a minor at least 17 years old, if the minor meets all other qualifications to be a registered voter of the county.
2. Must be able to speak, read and write the English language.
3. May not hold any other public or political party office: and
4. May not be a candidate for any public or political party office, a campaign manager for a candidate, or a treasurer for a candidate or political committee.
