Stay or Go?

You will have to decide whether to stay or go, based on the situation. Monitor news reports to listen to directions from local authorities. You may also receive an automated call with emergency instructions.

If evacuation is recommended :

- Tell friends & family where you can be reached
- Leave early so you have time to reach your destination safely
- Unplug appliances
- Lock doors and windows and bring your keys
- Gather your family, pets, and emergency kits.
- Do you have elderly neighbors that may need your help evacuating to safety?

What do I bring?

*** Face masks/coverings and hand sanitizer**

- Glasses, medical supplies, oxygen and several days supply of medication
- Diapers and formula
- Important papers in a waterproof bag
- Bedding, change of clothes and shoes.
- Personal and feminine hygiene items (toothbrush, toothpaste, towel and washcloth etc.)
- Comfort items, chargers and quiet entertainment, (teddy bear, books, cards, games, etc.)
- Any special dietary needs

*You are responsible for your personal belongings.
We recommend you do not bring valuables to a shelter

Pet Evacuation

Bring the following along with your pets:

- Leash, collar and crate if you have one
- Muzzle if they bite
- Dry or easy to open food
- Pet medications and shot/health records
- Litter box and waste bags
