

RESOLUTION NO. 898

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners for Somerset County adopted the Right To Farm Ordinance (Ordinance No. 719) in April of 2000 to protect a person's right to farm or engage in agricultural and forestry operations; and

WHEREAS, The Right To Farm Ordinance was adopted by virtue of the authority contained in Section 2-410 of the Somerset County Code of Public Local Laws; and


WHEREAS, The Somerset County Code of Public Local Laws was updated and reprinted in 2003 by the State Department of Legislative Services, resulting in the renumbering of certain sections within the Code; and


WHEREAS, The Right To Farm Ordinance has been renumbered and is now contained in Section 2-413 of the Somerset County Code of Public Local Laws.




